This is provided at no cost to parents. In addition, the Diocese offers low cost student insurance. This extends “school time” coverage to a full 24 hours a day. The coverage is for doctor’s visits, x-rays, surgeries, etc. resulting from accidental injuries. The cost is \$69/student/year. Dental Accident Insurance can be purchased for \$16/student/year.
