This just in:

Income Tax Deduction for Elementary and Secondary School Tuition (La. R.S. 47:297:10)

This allows an income tax deduction for amounts paid during the tax year for tuition and fees required for enrollment in a nonpublic elementary or secondary school. Beginning with the 2011 tax year, the deduction is for the full amount of tuition and fees per dependent, limited to \$5,000. The total amount of the deduction may not exceed the taxpayer's total taxable income.

You may use your cash receipt that was given when you paid tuition in May, 2011 or your cancelled check. Any tuition and fee amounts paid in 2011, including loan payments to First Bank and Trust, qualify.

Please note that the tuition and fees for 2011-12 were:

\$285: registration fee for the 1st child in the family

\$200: registration fee for each additional child in the family

\$3,650: tuition for the 1st child in the family qualifying as identified givers of SJV, Immaculate Conception, St. Anthony or St. Patrick parishes

\$3,550: tuition for each additional child in the family qualifying as identified givers of SJV, Immaculate Conception, St. Anthony or St. Patrick parishes

\$3,910: tuition for the 1st child in the family not identified as stated above

\$3,810: tuition for each additional child in the family not identified as stated above
