Dear Parents,

The Louisiana Department of Revenue offers a tax deduction for fees paid to private schools, under the revised statute: *La. R.S. 47:297:10 Income Tax Deduction for Elementary and Secondary School Tuition*. Under the law, the deduction is allowable in **the tax year that the tuition is paid** by the parent or guardian who claims the student as a dependent. ***Paid*** would be defined as funds being transferred via cash, check or online payment from the taxpayer to *St. Jean Vianney Catholic School* for qualifying expenses. This also includes payments made to *FACTS* for tuition expenses. The taxpayer must retain all expense receipts as proof of payment. Your bank statement showing drafts or canceled checks serves as your record of payment for tax purposes. St. Jean Vianney School's tax ID is **72-1037884**.
